Treasurer: Responsibilities of the treasurer include ensuring all financial activity is documented and accounted for, prepare and present the treasurer's report at each meeting, ensure chapter dues are submitted to National on time, prepare the treasurer report for submission with the annual report, and develop a proposed budget for the upcoming year to be presented at the board retreat annually.
